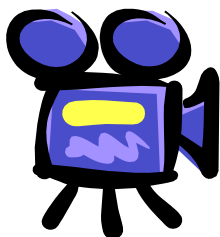


Moviemaker Summer Workshop Shanthy Mandir June - August, 2006

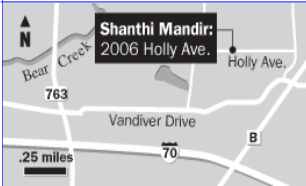
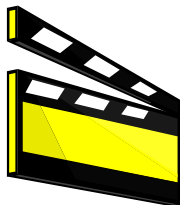


During the workshop participants will brainstorm ideas for story (stories), prepare a story board, write and edit the script, plan the production schedule, film the scenes both video and stills, select and edit audio and narration, edit the video and still images, and produce a digital video tape and a DVD of the finished product. Participants will be exposed to many popular software for audio and video capture and editing.

Instruction in the form of 1-2 hour-long guest lectures from professional TV reporters, journalists, technical and narrative content lectures from appropriate individuals, assistance for audio, video editing and movie production will be provided on a "as and when needed" basis throughout the summer. The instruction schedule will be

tailored to allow for participants to take time out for vacations or outings. The team(s) **only need to meet global deadlines** for various activities. Team work and achieving self-imposed deadlines will be among the peripheral experiences gained.

Depending upon the level of interest teams will work on documentaries and/or fictional stories. One group will be assigned to work on a documentary of Shanthy Mandir and its current activities. Short documentaries on community activism to improve quality of life in Columbia is another possibility.
