- Pin the tail

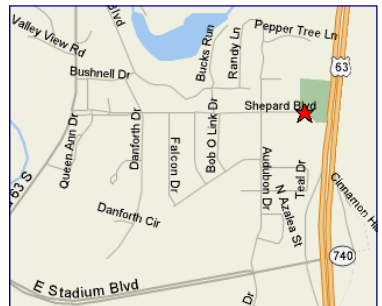
**Award certificates will be presented to recognize youth who participated in the various HTCC activities to-date.**

### Directions to Shepard Blvd. Park:

Head east on Stadium (MO 740) past Old 63, turn left on Audubon Drive (Highway 63 will be visible ahead, also Hollywood theatre will be visible to the right), turn right on Shepard Blvd (which ends at the city park). You may park the car on the terminal street or at the Shepard Blvd. Elementary School parking lot across the street.

Shepard Blvd. Park has a shelter with 8 picnic tables, lights, 4-110 volt double outlets, drinking fountain, rest rooms, 0.2 mile walking trail, soccer field, and a sand volleyball court. A full basketball court and 2 tennis courts are available at the Shepard Blvd. Elementary School across the street.
